



CGI MAP-Financial Hardship Guidelines

The following figures are the 2017 HHS poverty guidelines which are scheduled to be published in the *Federal Register* on January 26, 2017

For families/households with more than eight people, add \$4,180 for each additional person.

2016 POVERTY GUIDELINES FOR THE 48 CONTIGUOUS STATES AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

- Patients at or below 100% of the poverty level are discounted at 100%
- Patients that are at or between 101% and 120% of the poverty level are charged at 10% of the bill amount.
- Patients that are at or between 121% and 140% of the poverty level are charged at 25% of the bill amount.
- Patients that are at or between 141% and 160% of the poverty level are charged at 40% of the bill amount.
- Patients that are between 141% and 160% of the poverty level are charged at 50% of the bill amount.
- Patients that are at or between 161% and 180% of the poverty level are charged at 70% of the bill amount. Patients that are at or between 181% and 200% of the poverty level are charged 85% of the bill amount.
- Patients that are above 200% of the poverty level do not qualify for the CGI MAP-Financial Hardship Plan
